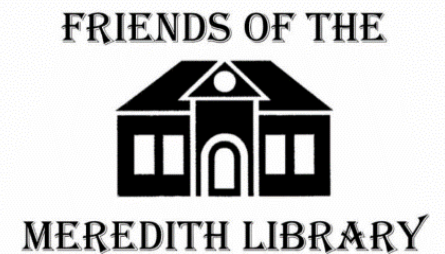
The Friends of the Meredith Library is a nonprofit 501c3 charitable organization. Your membership is tax-deductible as provided by law.
